

RE: RPS-250 Removal from 1st September 2023

As of 1st September 2023, the RPS250 will be removed by the Environment Agency (EA). This RPS refers to waste wood from demolition, and elements of construction and how it is handled.

The onus will be on the producers of waste wood to classify the waste properly and in accordance with guidance as set out by the Wood Recyclers Association (WRA) & National Federation of Demolition Contractors (NFDC), see the below annex & link.

The ten items below from pre-2007 buildings may contain hazardous elements:

- barge boards
- external fascia
- soffit boards
- external joinery
- external doors
- roof timber
- tiling cladding
- tiling battens
- timber frames
- timber joists
