Practical steps

In order to put these principles into place we will:

The management and staff are encouraged to commute by either car sharing, public transport or cycling to work.

Where practical numerous skips will be loaded onto one vehicle as to reduce mileage and our carbon footprint.

We will seek to minimise fuel usage on plant equipment by switching off vehicles when not in use.

Our fleet of vehicles is a modern fleet and uses the product Ad Blue which reduces CO2 emissions.

Where practical we reduce our usage of paper and other office consumables, for example by double sided all paper use, electronic invoicing where possible, internal emails and where possible reuse computer equipment.

KCM Waste Management Ltd has invested in state-of-the-art recycling equipment and are now producing RDF (refuse derived fuel) which is currently exported to the European market where it is used in power stations as a fuel instead of fossil fuels to create energy, thus diverting waste from landfill.
